

# PRELIMINARY PUBLIC NOTICE D01-198-23

The United States Coast Guard is soliciting comments on a proposal by the Massachusetts Department of Transportation (MassDOT) to replace the General Edwards Bridge, a moveable bascule bridge, at Route 1A (North Shore Road / Lynnway) over the Saugus River with a fixed bridge.

The existing bridge is structurally deficient and functionally obsolete. The purpose of this project is to provide a safe and efficient crossing for vehicle and pedestrian traffic that serves the needs of waterway users. The objective is to construct a new bridge that would provide a structure life of at least 75 years.

MassDOT is preparing a Navigation Impact Report to evaluate the impact the proposed fixed bridge would have on vessels that pass through the bridge site. A Coast Guard Bridge Permit application has not yet been submitted but will be required for this project.

The Coast Guard is issuing this Preliminary Public Notice to solicit information on the clearances of the proposed fixed bridge. # **MINIMUM NAVIGATIONAL CLEARANCES:**

## **SOLICITATION OF COMMENTS:**

Mariners are requested to comment on the clearances of the proposed fixed bridge, impacts to navigation, safety issues, including the need for clearance gauges and extended nighttime navigation through the bridge.

Boat owners are requested to provide information about the ability of their vessel to transit through the bridge site with the proposed clearances including type of vessel, length overall, draft, beam, and height from the waterline to the highest fixed point. Also provide contact information, where the vessel is primarily moored and the frequency of passage through the bridge site (i.e., number of times per month – a round trip should be reported as two passages).

Interested parties are requested to express their views in writing on the proposed project, giving sufficient detail to establish a clear understanding of their reasons for support of or opposition to the proposed fixed bridge. Comments will be received for the record at the address above or by e- mail to <u>SMB-D1Boston-Bridges-PublicNotices@uscg.mil</u> through April 14, 2023.

It is requested that this information be brought to the attention of any person having an interest who may not have received a copy of this public notice.






