PUBLIC NOTICE (D8 DWB-895)

This is a follow-up to the original Public Notice dated August 27, 2020. The reason is that a Final Environmental Assessment/Finding Of No Significant Impact (FEA/FONSI) was completed and not a Categorical Exclusion as previously indicated. All other information in this public notice for the proposed bridge replacement is the same.

All interested parties are notified that an application dated August 15, 2020 has been received from the Missouri Department of Transportation by the Commander, Eighth Coast Guard District, for approval of location and plans for construction of the proposed Broadway Highway Bridge Replacement over a navigable waterway of the United States.

WATERWAY AND LOCATION: Missouri River, Mile 366.2, at Kansas City, Jackson County and Clay County, Missouri.

CHARACTER OF WORK: Construct a bridge over the Missouri River, Mile 366.2, that carries US 169 a vital commuter route and a heavily traveled freight corridor in Kansas City, Missouri. The southbound bridge will be two/three lanes and northbound bridge will consist of three traffic lanes plus a pedestrian path. The existing Broadway Highway Bridge, Mile 366.2, will be removed.

MINIMUM NAVIGATIONAL CLEARANCES:

ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) is the lead federal agency for satisfying the requirements of the National Environment Policy Act (NEPA). The FHWA is acting on behalf of the USCG for all environmental control laws. A FEA /FONSI was issued on May 15, 2020, pursuant to NEPA, as amended. The U.S. Coast Guard tentatively has determined that the proposed action will not have a significant impact for purposes of NEPA and plans to issue a FONSI for the project. Documents are available for review at the above address, Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

The project is considered an encroachment, but not a significant encroachment on the 100-year floodplain. The proposed superstructure will clear the 100-year flood elevation of +750.0 feet mean sea level (m.s.l.). The low steel of the bridge is 55.5 feet at 2% flowline elevation of 733.0 m.s.l.

A Water Quality Certification from the Missouri Department of Natural Resources in accordance with Section 401 of the Clean Water Act, as amended, certifying that reasonable assurance has been furnished that the project will be conducted in compliance with water quality standards of the State of Missouri will be applied for. The construction site lies outside of any designated Coastal Management areas and the Missouri Department of Transportation does not anticipate the project will pose any effects on coastal uses or resources within the same.

The decision as to whether to grant approval of the location and plans for the proposed action rests primarily upon the effect it has on navigation.

#### SOLICITATION OF COMMENTS:

Mariners are requested to comment on the placement of a bridge protective system and other navigational safety issues, including the need for clearance gauges and extent of nighttime navigation passing through the bridge to determine the need for bridge lighting. Boat owners in the project vicinity are requested to provide information about their vessels including type of vessel, length overall, draft, beam, and height from the waterline to the highest fixed point and to appurtenant structures (e.g., tuna towers, flying bridges, fixed antennas and radar units).

Interested parties are requested to express their views, in writing, on the proposed bridge project, giving sufficient detail to establish a clear understanding of their reasons for support of or opposition to the proposed work. Comments will be received at the office of the Commander (dwb), Eighth Coast Guard District Bridge Branch, Room 2.102D, 1222 Spruce Street, St. Louis, Missouri 63103-2832 through February 15, 2020.

We will forward comments of an environmental nature such as those regarding wildlife refuges, water fowl refuges, public parks, historic sites, wetlands, floodplain issues, air, water quality, etc. to the FHWA for appropriate handling.

It is requested that this information be brought to the attention of any person having an interest in this who may not have received a copy of this public notice.





VICINITY MAP



LOCATION MAP





