DEEP WATER ROUTE OFF THE EAST COAST OF LANGELAND

The Secretary-General has been informed by the Government of Denmark of the following changes to the "Deep Water route off the East Coast of Langeland" adopted by the ninth Assembly (Res.A.338(IK)) (Fourth edition of the IMCO Publication "Ships' Routeing", Part C, page I/3):

Geographical positions (1) and (2) in the description of the deep water route should be amended as follows:

These amendments will enter into force on 15 August 1980.
