PUBLIC NOTICE 09-02-23

All interested parties are herein notified that the Commander, Ninth Coast Guard District, has received application materials dated September 8, 2022 from the Village of Lemont, Illinois, for approval of location and plans for the construction of a bridge over a navigable waterway of the United States.

BRIDGE, WATERWAY AND LOCATION: Stephen Street Bike Trail Bridge, across the Chicago Sanitary and Ship Canal, mile 26.7, at the Village of Lemont, Cook County, Illinois.

CHARACTER OF WORK: The Village of Lemont plans to construct a mixed-use pedestrian and bicycle bridge which would be a new construction at this location. It would be 190.00-feet long from abutment-to-abutment, have an out-to-out width of approximately 14.00-feet, and vertical and horizontal clearances as noted below. The proposed bridge would connect downtown Lemont with existing and planned bike and pedestrian trails and parks immediately northwest of Lemont on both sides of the Chicago Sanitary and Ship Canal. Its proposed location is centered between the fixed Lemont High-Rise Bridge, approximately 250.00-feet to the west, and the Burlington Northern Santa Fe ("BNSF") Swing Bridge approximately 250.00-feet to the east.

MINIMUM NAVIGATIONAL CLEARANCES:

The proposed bridge would have clearances as described in the table below. It would not be the controlling structure for horizontal or vertical clearances on the Chicago Sanitary and Ship Canal.

Datum: All elevations are referenced Low Water Datum, 574.46-feet, International Great Lakes Datum of 1985 ("IGLD85").

ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The Federal Highway Administration ("FHWA") is the lead Federal agency for satisfying the requirements of the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA). FHWA is acting on behalf of the U.S. Coast Guard for all environmental control laws. It anticipates issuing a Categorical

Exclusion, pursuant to NEPA, as amended. The U.S. Coast Guard has tentatively determined that the proposed action will not have a significant impact for the purposes of NEPA for the project and anticipates issuing a Categorical Exclusion as well.

A water quality certification ("WQC") in accordance with Section 401 of the Clean Water Act, as amended, was issued via the Illinois Department of Natural Resources, Office of Water Resources Permit No. NE2023022 on March 24, 2023.

The Village of Lemont's permit application indicates that no wetlands will be taken or affected by this project. The Coast Guard defers to the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers ("USACE") regarding wetlands impact determinations. This application is being considered by the Chicago District, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE), under Section 14 of the Rivers and Harbors Act, 33 USC 408, as implemented in accordance with Engineer Circular 1165-2-220. USACE must determine whether the proposal will impair the usefulness of the Congressionally-authorized Illinois Waterway Navigation Project, and whether the proposed alteration is in the public interest. Commenters are requested to provide a copy of any comments on the proposed activity covered by this notice to Chicago408@usace.army.mil or by U.S. Mail to: Section 408 Coordinator, 231 LaSalle Street, Suite 1500, Attn: ORD-R, Chicago, IL 60604.

The project is not considered a significant encroachment on the 100-year floodplain. The area of the proposed bridge is listed as a FEMA Special Flood Hazard Area that is without a base flood elevation. No fill material is anticipated to be placed below high water datum for the construction of the bridge and approaches.

SOLICITATION OF COMMENTS:

Mariners are requested to comment on the proposed navigation clearances, placement of a bridge protective system and other navigational safety issues, including need for clearance gauges and extent of nighttime navigation to determine the need for bridge lighting. Interested parties are requested to express their views, in writing, on the proposed bridge project including its possible impacts to navigation.




Map of location and plans attached.



MILE 26.7 (USACE MILE 300.5)


