**INFORMATION ON A PROHIBITED ANCHORAGE AREA
IN INDONESIAN TERRITORIAL WATERS**

1 At the request of the Government of the Republic of Indonesia, the attached information on a prohibited anchorage area in Indonesian territorial waters near or around the lighthouse of Nipa is brought to the attention of Member Governments.

2 Member Governments are requested to bring the attached information to the attention of all concerned.

**INFORMATION ON THE PROHIBITED ANCHORAGE AREA
IN INDONESIAN TERRITORIAL WATERS**

1 Foreign ships are prohibited from anchoring in the Indonesian territorial waters near or around the lighthouse of Nipa, due to safety reasons. However, the Government of the Republic of Indonesia has designated an alternative area for foreign ships to anchor which is controlled by Port Administration Tanjung Balai Karimun, and managed by the Indonesian Port Corporation I - Belawan, located at:
