AMENDMENT TO THE GENERAL PROVISIONS ON SHIPS' ROUTEING  
(Resolution A.572(14))

With reference to the General Provisions on Ships' Routeing (Resolution A.572(14), operative paragraph 4)), the Maritime Safety Committee, at its sixtieth session (6 to 10 April 1992), adopted the following amendment:

Add the following sentence to paragraph 1.1:

"Ships' routeing may also be used for the purpose of preventing or reducing the risk of pollution or other damage to the marine environment caused by ships colliding or grounding in or near environmentally sensitive areas".
