SHIP MOVEMENT REPORTING SYSTEMS

1 The Sub-Committee on Safety of Navigation has been instructed by the Committee to develop international principles for Ship Movement Reporting Systems.

2 In order to proceed with the development of such systems, Member Governments are invited to provide information on any ship reporting services they may have instituted or envisage for general navigation purposes and in particular:

- .1 whether participation is voluntary or required by law;
- .2 the information to be included in such reports;
- .3 the radio frequency on which these reports should be transmitted.

3 Member Governments are invited to submit this information to the Secretariat before 1 June 1979.
